

VALUE VOLUME VARIETY II

National Juried Art Competition
Hosted By The 119th Street Artists of Whiting, Indiana

ELIGIBILITY: This exhibition is open to all residents of the United States. Source material must be original and not derived from copyrighted images. All works must have been completed within the last five years. No work done in class or under the tutelage of an instructor is eligible. 119th Street Artists reserves the right NOT to jury or display entries not complying with the conditions set forth or work considered too fragile for the exhibition.

SPECIFICATIONS: 2D and 3D works in acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, pencil, mixed media, ceramics and sculpture are eligible. All works must be framed or gallery wrapped (finished edges and no exposed staples) and wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers allowed. Frames and mats must be museum quality, clean and in good condition. Wires must be good enough and substantial enough to support the weight of the artwork. Glass accepted for hand delivered works. Plexiglass ONLY accepted for shipped entries. Hanging works may not exceed 30 lbs., and are limited to 48" in all directions including frame. A single unit sculpture cannot exceed 30" in width, 72" in height or 100 pounds. Each unit of a multi-unit sculpture cannot exceed the single unit limitations. All sculptures must be self-standing (if needed with a base and/or pedestal).

Selection will be made from a CD only. No original works or photos will be viewed during the jurying process. The images on the CD must be in jpeg format, at least 4 inches wide and minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Each image must be numbered with the initial of artist's first name and last name (i.e.: 01SJones.jpg) and must correspond to an included text (Word or WordPerfect) file listing the following information: item number, artist name, title, medium, size and sales price along with the entry form. All works must be **FOR SALE**.

ACCEPTED WORK: Attach identification tag to the top left corner of the back of your work listing artist's name and address, title of piece, medium and price. Artists are responsible for the cost of shipping. 119th Street Artists requires a call tag or pre-paid shipping label sent with the piece(s). All works will be returned in their original container. Artists may also personally deliver and pick-up accepted work. The gallery address is 119th Street Gallery, 1500 - 119th Street, Whiting, IN 46394.

LIABILITY AND SALES: Every possible care will be taken of all art work. 119th Street Artists assume no responsibility for loss or damage. Submissions of work for this competition will be construed as acceptance of all conditions printed on this prospectus. 119th Street Artists charge a commission of 20% on all sales made as a result of this competition and the resulting exhibition. 119th Street Artists reserves the right to photograph or reproduce the artwork(s) for publicity and educational purposes regardless of copyright.

CHECKLIST FOR ENTRIES

Entry Form: Completely fill in all spaces and Print Neatly or Type.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 for members and \$20.00 for non-members for up to four images on the CD. Multiple views of 3D work count as ONE. Additional entries are \$5.00 per 2 works of art.

Payment: Make checks payable to 119th Street Artists.

SASE: For return of the CD include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
